There are some problems that occasionally happen related to race discrimination. Where white people doing discrimination to black people. Where there is a woman named Aibleen. She works at the white house as housemaid. She spent her life working there, cooking, clean the house, wash, iron, shopping in the market and also raise their children that's what she does in white house.

From the many portraits of discrimination, and the many moral values that are displayed or articulated in the film The Help, then in this study the researcher uses the theory of moral values in literary works according to William Wordsworth. Wordsworth says (1990) a class a poetry would be produced, well adapted interest mankind permanently, and not unimportant in the quality, and in the multiplicity of its moral relations.

According to Wordsworth's opinion above, literature or literary works can be adapted from the moral values that exist in the conditions of society. Moral is the idea or goal that the author wants to convey through his work to the reader. It can be concluded that every literary work of any kind has a moral message contained in it, as well as a novel must have a meaning stored in it.

In Literature has more than a few functions. literary works deepen readers' awareness and their understanding of life and the world. It deepens their understanding of something that is already known. They know that killing, for example, is evil and sinful. However, their knowledge about life, and about what should and should not be done becomes more real, because portrayal invites them to enter and experience it. It also entertains the reader. It has the ability to make them respond emotionally. At the time of making them shed tears, sad, and melancholy. Sometimes it also makes them feel sorry or angry with them, and afraid of ourselves (Sumarjo, 1991, pp. 8-9).

A literary work includes many massages or moral values from the author to the reader. This is related to Plato's thoughts about literary works that can educate humans. In addition, in line with Palmer (1992, p. 92) argues the purpose of decomentary is to provide information, persuade, or maybe in some cases to average good to acction. In addition, dealing with Palmer:

We cannot even begin to understand fiction unless we presuppose the same strength of relations between the fictional deed and the fictional doer. When we engage with fictional work we do not understand or respond to fictional characters as perculiar creatures motions of doing; they must be seen as 'authors' of their own actions in the way that we suppose ourselves to be 'authors' of ours (Palmer, 1992, p. 121)

Because the quote explains through character, it can show moral value. Characters in literary works can be referred to as writers. They can be represented by writers to give moral value through their actions in the story. The author writes a literary work with the aim of giving moral value to the reader. The reader can know how goodness in a literary work can be applied in real life.

According to Palmer that "to know what we learn from literature we must know what literature can contribute to our education first (education is related to what is good) and what literature can contribute to our moral education (all education has moral dimensions)" (Palmer, 1992, p. 181). The investigation of the novel Miracle is to find out how and in what way our understanding and appreciation of literary works.

Furthermore, according to Nurgiyantoro (1998, p. 321) a literary work has valuable moral values. That value is universal. Everyone is convincing about the goodness in life. Moral values in literary works can be universally accepted but background to people. Therefore, there are moral values that Wonder R. J. Palacio wants to provide some massage for the reader through narration in the novel. There are three categories of moral values: (a) Relationship between human beings and own self. Like human in real life, character in a literary work also has problem with himself. Character has problem for instance frightened, timidity, and shy. Then, character can solve his problem with wisdom, kindness and mature. (b) Relationship between human beings and other. As social beings, human do interaction each other to keep a good relationship. In a literary work, characters do also interaction with other character. They sometimes have a problem like in the real life. (c) Relationship between human beings and God. Despite fiction, a literary work also shows how relationship between character and God. Character has a hope to God about kindness of life.

Values and literature are complemetary and are insperable. Literary works born and sourced from human life and have a high value. Literature will be a contribution to the formation of values so that lovers of literature will be civilized, well-mannered, and virtuous men, and agreeing with the applicable rules. The values in the literature usually reflect the views of the author's life or values that are attractive to the author and are necessary to convey to the readers (Siahaan, 2019, p. 76).

Literary work according to Horace (in Teeuw, 1998, p. 8) is "Dulce et Utile" it is mean to delight and useful. In a good literary work, the readers will get the pleasure and usefulness provided by literary works in the form of beauty and high value experiences directly or indirectly.

According to Darma (2004, pp. 9-10). Horace considers, a good art work, including literature, is always have two criteria, namely *dulce et utile*, meaning that literature must be good, interesting, and giving pleasure. In addition, literature must provide benefits or uses for example inner wealth, life insight, and morals.

Agreeing with the explanation above, Budianta (in Kurniawan, 2009, p. 6) Horatius state that the function of literary works is *dulce et utile*, meaning that

literature has a dual function, namely entertaining and at the same time useful. Entertaining because literary works contain stories about life that are unique, interesting, and fun. So that is liked by many people, and useful because in the real life told that full of messages of meaning that can be obtained by the reader.

As to *utile*, it means that literature is morally good or worthy. We can say a literary text should include beauty and ethic. The writer says beauty because pleasure got from a literary text has something to do with the beauty of it. Humo writes that beauty is something that can evoke pleasure (Habib Mustopo, 1989, p. 100).

The latter issue is taken from Horace's saying. He says, 'Aut prodesse volunt aut delectare poetae/Aut simul et iucunda et idonea dicere vitae' means that poets wish to either benefit or delight us, or at one and the same time, to speak words that are both pleasing and useful for our lives.

Like Horace, Sidney also speaks the same. The right author of a literary work, to Sidney, are those 'who imitate both to delight and teach, and delight to movement to take that goodness in hand, which without delight they would flye as from a stranger' (Abrams, in Lodge 1998, p. 11). To Sir Philip Sidney, the moral effect is the terminal aim, to which delight and emotion are auxiliary (Abrams in Lodge, 1998, p. 12). Johnson also claims that the end of literary work is to instruct by pleasing (1998, p. 15).

The usefulness value of literary works is one of the criteria of a good work, because through the presentation of the story, the author gives a new dimension of existing reality and then provides new life experiences and ways of looking at life wisely and full of wisdom and virtue for its readers. Thus, the literary work is not just entertainment but can shape the behavior of life (Sumarjo, 1991, p. 37).

This research uses literary criticism methods and structural approach that are needed to obtain in-depth data and careful reading of the text, a data that contains meaning. Literary criticism is not just judging, but there is still another activity that analyzes the work. As stated by Abrams that literary criticism is a study related to defining, classifying, parsing or analyzing, and appraisal or evaluation. Literary criticism is one type of essay, i.e. good or bad consideration of a literary outcome. That development certainly gives a reason for the content and form of literary results. Literary criticism is a study that is faced with the literary work, directly discussing the literary work with an emphasis on the assessment (Wellek in Suratno, 2010: 14).

The research focuses on finding and discussing moral values are found in the literature which is a little more capable of giving lessons to readers. As well as finding out and analyzing how the director Tate Teylor conveyed the moral values in her work in this research the writer used "The Help" movie. This issue was raised by Skeeter which also became a bridge for her career development. So, it's no wonder that Skeeter is so worried about Aibileen's safety, considering that her role is also important in their movement. But even so, because Minny cares so much for her best friend, Aibileen, as well as for Skeeter, she believes that she and Aibileen can take care of each other while Skeeter is away and focus on her career.

Tolerance

This term in the context of culture and religion means attitudes and deeds that prohibit the discrimination of a group or other groups that have differences of belief in societal life.

As you well know, in this film, negro maids are strictly prohibited from eating at the same dining table, they even tend to eat in the kitchen, they are not allowed to use the same spoon to taste the food they are cooking, the plates and spoons they use tend to be distinguished unlike those commonly used by the host. Even for things like bathroom matters, negro maids are not allowed to use the bathroom in the house. They are provided with a separate bathroom which, of course, cannot be said to be sufficient in quality, moreover, it is usually placed in the yard or outside the house.




Prayers


CONCLUSION
